**April 18, 1918 - Oct. 9, 2010**

Maria Liliias Harrell, 92, of Asheville, NC and formerly of Albany, GA, died Saturday, October 9, 2010, at the Wood Assisted Living Center at Givens Estate in Asheville, NC. Miss Harrell was born in Butler, GA on April 18, 1918 and was a daughter of the late Rev. Dr. Luther Alonzo Harrell and Mary Quillian Harrell.
