The Reverend McLendon "Mac" Harding Jamison, of Morganton, went to be with his Lord on Sunday, September 9, 2012 at Burke Hospice. Born July 3rd 1921 in Asheville, N.C. he was the son of the late Robert Jay Jamison and Grace Watkins Jamison. He attended Gardner Webb College in Boiling Springs, N.C. where he was recognized as a member of the Honorary Alumni. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife of 62 years, Mattie Melton Jamison, a brother, William Robert Jamison, Sr. and his "precious baby sister" Ruth Jamison Cline.
